

Rules of Texas Tactical Jeep Club, Inc.

I. Mission Statement

Texas Tactical Jeep Club, Inc. is a Family Friendly club that love to get together for any reason so that we can hang out as a FAMILY. We strive to help teach and guide you in your Off-road experience. We practice Tread-lightly and have a big involvement in our community. Our name says Jeeps but we do not mind other 4X4s of the like manner.

II. Membership Requirements

Requirements for current members and prospective members include the following:

(a) Be the owner of a vehicle produced by any of the following:

- (i) Bantam Corporation;
- (ii) Willys-Overland Corporation;
- (iii) Kaiser Motor Company;
- (iv) American Motors Jeep Division;
- (v) Daimler Chrysler Jeep Division;
- (vi) Chrysler Group Keep Division; or
- (vii) or of like manner 4X4 vehicles (discretion of the officers).

(b) A Texas Tactical Jeep Club member must be over 18 years old and possess a valid driver's license.

(c) All driving members must maintain liability and no-fault insurance as required by the state of Texas.

(d) Each member must maintain on file, with Texas Tactical Jeep Club, current Member Information forms including a signed **Waiver of Liability** and **Emergency Medical Contract Information**. Each member must meet all current **Vehicle Equipment Requirements**.

(e) Texas Tactical Jeep Club will not be held responsible for injuries to a member and/or guest. Texas Tactical Jeep Club will not be responsible for any damage or loss to any vehicle or personal property at any organized event, meeting or scheduled trail ride.

III. Dues

(a) Dues are payable at the time of application; or as per schedule by officers of the club.

(b) Dues shall be \$100/lifetime per vehicle to support the club's fiscal commitments, administration and activities.

(c) Dues shall be payable to the "Texas Tactical Jeep Club, Inc.". A receipt will be issued for monies paid.

IV. Conduct and Activity Rules

(a) All members must conduct themselves in a respectable and orderly manner. Any member not doing so may be subject to dismissal. In the event of a dismissal due to conduct, the former member will not be due any refund of dues, fees or other monies.

(b) Members will be responsible for the actions of their guests.

(c) Texas Tactical Jeep Club promotes a family oriented environment and does not allow the consumption of alcohol or any controlled substance prior to or during any official club event where driving is involved. Consumption of alcohol or any controlled substance while driving during any official event will constitute dangerous and unsafe behavior and will be subject to review by the club officers. This action may result in immediate revocation of all membership rights and participation of all club events.

(d) Texas Tactical Jeep Club strives to maintain a safe, responsible, family oriented environment; therefore we strongly discourage our members from possessing weapons during any club events unless they have a carry license. Any member, who chooses to possess a weapon during an event, does so at his or her own risk. Any instance of a member possessing a weapon without a carry license during an event will constitute dangerous and unsafe behavior. Under the club bylaws these incidents will be subject to review by the club officers for possible dismissal. This action may result in immediate revocation of all membership rights and participation in all club events.

V. Trail Ride Rules

(a) The President, Event Coordinator, Trail Boss and club officer(s) are in charge of all official rides and have ultimate authority for all rides and the safety of scheduled club events.

(b) Members must have on file a ***Waiver of Liability***. Guests must sign a waiver before participating in an event. It is the responsibility of the Event Coordinator and Trail Boss to ensure that all participants have completed Waivers.

(c) All vehicles must meet all club vehicle requirements as certified by the Trail Boss.

(d) Do not travel in unauthorized areas "Tread Lightly".

(e) Pets must be controlled by their owner.

(f) Do not litter! **YOU HAUL IT IN, YOU HAUL IT OUT!**

VI. Vehicle Equipment

(a) Vehicles must be maintained in a safe manner, be properly tagged and be in compliance with all federal, state and local laws, unless it's strictly an off-road vehicle. Each driver must have a valid driver's license, proof of insurance and current member information on file with Texas Tactical Jeep Club including a signed **Waiver of Liability, Emergency Contact Information**; and meet all current **Vehicle Equipment Requirements**.

(b) Towropes or straps are required. No hooks or metal ends.

(c) Safety belts (one for each occupant). All individuals must be properly restrained by factory or better equipment inside any moving vehicle on a club ride.


(d) Spare tire, jack and lug wrench.

(e) Front and rear tow points are required. Tow points must be frame mounted.

(f) All vehicles must have a functioning exhaust system for both noise control and fire suppression purposes.

(g) Appropriate protective clothing and footwear will be required for all members. The Trail Boss and/or club officers have the ultimate authority to assure the safety of all participants.


(h) Appropriate tires for terrain, i.e., all terrain or mud terrain type tire. Inadequate tread depth or wear will be subject to review the Trail Boss prior to any scheduled trail ride.
